What: Reroute of lines 66,180 and 181

City: San Jose

Duration: 1 pm Friday, August 22 through 4 am Monday, August 25

Why: Light Rail Construction

Street Closures: 1st and Devine

Routes Affected: Lines 66, 180 and 181

Notes: Operators will observe all coach stops along reroute. Operators will observe all stop requests when safe

LINES 66,180,181 NORTHBOUND: From 1st, Right on Saint James, Left on 3rd, Right on Empire, Left on 4th, Left on Taylor, Right on 1st to regular route.

PLEASE NOTE: A temporary bus stop will be placed on 3rd and Empire for passengers whose destination is Japantown/Ayer.
