What: Reroute of lines 34, 35, 51, 52

City: Mountain View

Duration: June 5, July 3, August 7, September 4

Time: 2:00 Pm to 10:00 pm

Why: Annual Street Events

Street Closures: Castro, between Evelyn and Mercy

Routes Affected: Lines 34, 35, 51, 52

Notes: Operators will observe all coach stops along reroute. Operators will observe all stop requests when safe

LINE 34 EASTBOUND: From Shoreline, Right on Central exit, Left on Central, Left on Whisman exit, Right on Whisman, Right on S. Whisman, Right on Dana, Right on Calderon, Left on Evelyn to Mt View Transit Center. (Temporary stop located at Central and Castro)

LINE 34 WESTBOUND: From Mt View Transit Center, Right on Evelyn, Right on Castro, Left on Central, Right on Shoreline exit, onto Shoreline, Left on Montecito to regular route.

LINE 35 NORTHBOUND: From Mt View Transit Center, Right on Evelyn, Right on Castro, Left on Central, Right on Shoreline exit, onto Shoreline, Right on California to regular route. (Temporary stop located at Shoreline and Villa.

LINE 35 SOUTHBOUND (after 6pm): From California Left on Shoreline, Right on Central exit, Left on Central, Left on Whisman exit, Right on Whisman, Right on S. Whisman, Right on Dana, Right on Calderon, Left on Evelyn to Mt View Transit Center. (Temporary stops located on Shoreline Blvd and California, Shoreline and Villa, Central and Castro.)

LINE 51 NORTHBOUND: From Castro, Right on El Camino, Left on Calderon, Left on Evelyn, Right on Castro to regular route.

LINE 51 SOUTHBOUND: From Moffett, Right on Central, Right on Shoreline, Left on El Camino, Right on Castro to regular route. (temporary stops located on Shoreline and Villa, Shoreline and California, Shoreline and Latham, El Camino and Shoreline @ 22 bus stop.)

LINE 52 NORTHBOUND: From El Camino, Left on Calderon, Left on Evelyn to Mt View Transit Center.

LINE 52 SOUTHBOUND: From Mt View Transit Center, Left on Evelyn, Right on Calderon, Right on El Camino to regular route.
